

**FINAL BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES**

**PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Leslie Ford Notaro, followed by a Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

**Roll Call:** Present were Councilmembers Marv Behm, Glenn Gunn, Wanda Schwerer, and Jody Shirley; Mayor Leslie Ford Notaro, City Manager Lynn Rives, City Clerk Patricia Gentry, Finance Officer Melanie Kruszona, and City Attorney Paul Marino. Councilmember John Pietrowski was unable to attend.

**1. Consideration of Resolution 2018-19, A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Belleair Beach, Florida, Establishing the Final Ad Valorem Millage Rate for the Fiscal Year 2018-2019, for the City of Belleair Beach, Florida, at 2.0394 Mills; and Establishing an Effective Date.**

Mayor Notaro read Resolution 2018-19 by Title only.

Mayor Notaro stated “The final millage rate for fiscal year 2018-2019 is 2.0394 mills, which is higher than the rolled back rate of 1.9278 mills. The rolled back rate is the millage rate that will provide the same ad valorem tax revenue as was levied during the prior year. The rolled back rate is higher than last fiscal year’s due to an increase in this year’s property values by 5.77%. The reason for setting the millage rate at 2.0394 is to fund expenses for the General Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.”

Mayor Notaro opened the Public Hearing.

Seeing no one, the Public Hearing was closed.

**MOTION** was made by Councilmember Schwerer and seconded by Councilmember Behm for Resolution 2018-19.

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Mayor Notaro stated "The final millage rate for the City of Belleair Beach is 2.0394 mills for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019 and is 5.79% higher than the rolled back rate of 1.9278 mills due to a 5.77% increase in property values. The purpose for setting the millage rate at 2.0394 is to fund the General Fund expenses for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019."

**2. Consideration of Resolution 2018-20, A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Belleair Beach, Florida, Making Appropriations for Certain Expenditures, Expenses, Capital Improvements and Certain Indebtedness of the City of Belleair Beach, Florida, for the Fiscal Year Beginning October 1, 2018, and Ending September 30, 2019; and Establishing an Effective Date.**

Mayor Notaro read Resolution 2018-20 by Title only.

Mayor Notaro opened the Public Hearing.

Seeing no one, the Public Hearing was closed.
