### Belle Isle Drainage Project

Begins October 22, 2018. Belle Isle Avenue and Hibiscus Drive will have on lane of traffic at times.

Construction to be completed by January 2019. The Project will include installation of new drainage out fall and check valve to limit the high tide back flow.

### Red Tide Update

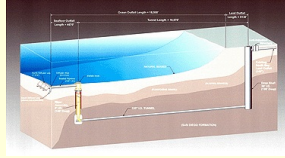
County has shown medium concentrations of the algae bloom along our shoreline. The county is continuing their efforts with fish kill collection along the coast and the intracoastal waterway.

The contractor will collect fish kill as close to shore as possible, however, they will not leave the boat or go on to docks or private property. City Staff is also removing the fish kill along our beach and facilities.

The fish kill collected to date is 2,064,000 pounds.

## Drainage Project



The Drainage Project begins October 22, 2018. First Street and Harbor Drive will be closed to all but local traffic. Construction to be completed late January 2019. The project will include drainage pipe and size with an addition outfall to be installed through the Park on Harbor Drive.

Both outfalls will have check valves installed to limit high tide back-flow. First and Harbor Drive will have new curb, inlet drains and paving.
