- **Providing Fire Prevention/Emergency Preparedness information and First Aid during Community Events**
- **Provide support personnel for the PSFRD Emergency Operations Center during Hurricanes**
- **Giving back to the communities we serve with fund raising for local food pantries and holiday toy drives for local underprivileged children.**

We provide our members with training in:

- **First Aid and CPR**
- **Shelter management**
- **Emergency Operations Support functions**
- **Special Needs evacuation transportation training**
- **Search techniques**
- **WebEOC training**

- Map and compass training
- Incident Command course training
- Fire Extinguisher training
- Hazmat awareness training
- Emergency patient triage, moving, and packaging for transportation during major disaster
