

PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 7:35pm by Mayor Dave Gattis, followed by a Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Roll Call: Present were Councilmembers Frank Bankard, Leslie Notaro, Lloyd Roberts, Jody Shirley, and Mike Zabel; Mayor Dave Gattis, Vice Mayor Glenn Gunn, Interim City Manager Kyle Riefler, City Clerk Patricia Gentry, and Consultant Lynn Rives.

1. Consideration of setting the Tentative Millage Rate for FY 2022-2023.

MOTION was made by Councilmember Shirley and seconded by Councilmember Zabel to set the tentative millage rate for FY 2022-2023 at the current rate of 2.0394 mills.

Mayor Gattis stated it is estimated that the proposed tentative millage rate of 2.0394 mills will be an additional \$177,775 in revenue or nearly 14% more than the fiscal year 2021-2022 budget. As last year, this is primarily due to the increase in property values. This is a tentative rate, the final rate can be lower, but cannot be higher.

Discussion included, in part:

- The merits of considering any portion of a rolled-back rate for the tentative millage rate considering the current 9% rate of inflation, and if the rolled-back rate would later need to be followed by an increase in the tax rate.

VOTE for the Tentative Millage Rate was taken on one of two options previously discussed - out of the four options that were presented in the report to Council. The two options were:

- Option A is the rolled-back rate of 1.7916 mills
- Option B is the current rate of 2.0394 mills

Councilmember Bankard voted for: B
Councilmember Notaro voted for: B
Councilmember Roberts voted for: B
Councilmember Shirley voted for: B
Councilmember Zabel voted for: B
Vice Mayor Gunn voted for: B
Mayor Gattis voted for: B

Motion for Option B to set the Tentative Millage Rate at 2.0394 mills passed 7-0.

MOTION was made by Councilmember Notaro and seconded by Councilmember Zabel to adjourn at 7:50pm.

Motion passed 7-0.
