



**Special City Council Meeting  
City of Belleair Beach, Florida**

**Monday, August 22, 2022  
Community Center, 6:00pm**

### **PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Gattis, followed by a Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

**Roll Call:** Present were Councilmembers Frank Bankard, Leslie Notaro, Lloyd Roberts, Jody Shirley, and Mike Zabel; Mayor Dave Gattis, Vice Mayor Glenn Gunn, Interim City Manager Kyle Riefler, City Clerk Patricia Gentry, and City Attorney Randy Mora.

Kenneth C. Griffin was also present.

#### **1. Discuss City Manager Contract.**

Discussion regarding Mr. Griffin's contract included, in part:

- The budget has been stretched to try to make this contract work
- A \$300 monthly car allowance or a mileage reimbursement
- Mr. Griffin's request for the City to add his spouse to his insurance and pay 72% of that cost - or approximately \$11,500 of the \$16,092 cost
- If spousal insurance is offered to one employee, it should be offered to all employees
- Options other than the City insurance for Mr. Griffin to obtain and pay for his spouse's insurance

Attorney Mora stated that the current offer with the salary, retirement contribution, car allowance, and phone allowance, the contract is at approximately \$180,000 to \$190,000 in compensation, not including the spousal insurance.

Mr. Griffin stated that he currently pays approximately \$4,200 for his and his wife's insurance. He offered to have the \$3,600 car allowance go towards the

\$16,092 spousal insurance coverage, and then he would pay 50% and the City would pay 50% of the balance.

Consensus of Council was that they would not include the spousal insurance in addition to the contract conditions that had been offered.

Attorney Mora asked Mr. Griffin if he was still interested in the position without the spousal insurance.

Mr. Griffin stated he would take it under consideration and contact Attorney Mora with his decision.

**ADJOURN**

**MOTION** was made by Councilmember Bankard and seconded by Councilmember Zabel to adjourn.
