Consideration of Ordinance 20-05, An Ordinance Of The City Council Of The City Of Belleair Beach, Florida, Relating To Three (3) Proposed Charter Amendments For Submission To Referendum; Providing For Incorporation Of Recitals; Providing For Amendments To Article II, Section 2.01, Article III, Section 3.01, And Article V, Section 5.03 Of The City Charter; Providing For Three (3) Ballot Titles; Providing For City Clerk To Obtain Spanish Language Translation; Providing For Approval By The Majority Of Electors Voting In The Election Scheduled For March 9, 2021; Providing For A Notice Of An Advertisement Of The Referendum Election To Be Published In Accordance With The State Of Florida Election Code; Providing That Upon Adoption Of This Ordinance The Three (3) Proposed Charter Amendments Shall Be Submitted To The Qualified Electors Of The City Of Belleair Beach, Florida, Voting In The Election Scheduled For March 9, 2021 And Shall Become Effective As Provided By Law; Providing For The City Clerk To Conform And Codify The Charter Amendments To The Charter If Approved; Providing For Repeal Of Ordinances In Conflict Herewith; Providing For Severability; Providing An Effective Date; And Providing For An Effective Date(s) Of Proposed Charter Amendment(s). (Second Reading)**


